

COVĂȘĂNȚ (Arad County)

Covășanț is a village in Arad country (Transylvania, Romania).

Geography

Covășanț village is situated at the grounds of the Zarand mountaines, on the Matca channel, at 28 km away from Arad.

The total population arises to 2659 inhabitants of different nationalities.

History

The village has been attested for the first time in 1332, Covășanț taking the name of a community that lived on that period during the stone age. In Covășanț was also discovered an important thesaurus consisting in 300 roman coins, bracelets rings and other bronze objects.
